From 27 to 29 May 2026, the Fair Mobility Festival will gather researchers, activists, journalists, artists, planners, policymakers, and practitioners in Vienna and Ebensee to rethink mobility through the lens of equity, accessibility, and socio-spatial justice. This three-day event is a space for intersectional exchange, where the voices of women, gender minorities, and marginalized communities take centre stage in shaping the future of mobility.

Through walking tours, film screenings, hands-on workshops, and lively debates, we will explore how mobility planning and access to public life can work for everyone—especially women, gender minorities, and marginalized communities. Whether you're passionate about urban justice, care-based travel, or just love a good conversation about fair cities, this festival is for you.
